Area happenings....

NvFRW Legislative Day - April 17th;

Fernley RW sent 5 representatives to the federation legislative day: Carol Franich, Candace McCarthy, Lorrie Olson, Patti Palmer and Peggy Gray. In total, about 70 were in attendance from the other clubs around the state.

In the morning, groups were broke into teams and each team visited from 3-4 Assembly members asking for their "NO' vote on AJR6, which proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to adopt the National Popular Vote Company, thus eliminating the Electoral College and making Nevada voters irrelevant in a presidential election. Unfortunately, this resolution passed on the Assembly floor

on a partisan vote.

We then met with Governor Lombardo who spoke about the five bills he submitted to the legislature. After lunch we convened in an Assembly hearing room. Republican Assembly members told of bills they sponsored, the frustration of being in the super-minority, and how and why they were recruited or just plain decided to run for elected office.

#### May Speaker: Kathi McGathey, Operations Manager for Reno's Veterans Guest House

Kathi gave a very informative update of the Veterans Guest Home in Reno to the FRW membership on May 16, 2023. Typically the Guest Home services an area of 164,000 miles, but takes in veterans from all over the world. The Guest Home began with just 12 bedrooms in 2004 when it was remodeled and today it has grown into 3 properties housing 35 bedrooms, dining room, and other facilities necessary to operate.

The Veterans Guest House operates through donations only. Many of the services offered are donated by people with a desire to help our veterans. Volunteers help with housekeeping, maintenance, transportation, and cooking. They have even offered to babysit (kennel) pets while a service member attends doctor appointments or even during hospital confinement for surgery. The Veterans Guest House doesn't just stop with temporary housing, they also have a program to help homeless veterans with training, housing, furniture, and even help with rent.

The Fernley Republican Women's group is proud to be a small part in helping the Veterans Guest House by donating food, money, and supplies. Kathi was presented with a donation from the FRW for the Veterans Guest House at the conclusion of her presentation.


