

## **Message from the President**



Vida Keller, President September 2023 message



"It's been a tumultuous year, and now we find ourselves in fall. The leaves are turning, the weather is getting cooler, and I'm observing more people out and about. This signals a time of increased community involvement.

The legislative session concluded months ago, and we are still grappling with its affects as we prepare for another election next year. 2024 will be a pivotal year as we elect our next President of the United States.

Since the last presidential election, we have endured significant challenges, including rising inflation, interest rates, and a lack of security. Recent events at the Nevada State Republican Central Committee meeting in Winnemucca have now outlined the process for the next presidential caucus and state presidential primary. The Nevada Republican Party, representing 'We the People,' has decided not to participate in the state-run primary on February 6, 2024. Instead, it will uphold its tradition of a presidential caucus on February 8, 2024.

The Presidential Caucus will be held in your communities during the precinct meetings, just as we did in 2016. I urge you to become actively involved, engage your family and friends, and help make this the most extensive statewide caucus our state has ever witnessed. It's imperative that we cast our votes wisely, as we must send the right person to run in November to restore our country. Staying at home is not an option.
